

## RESOLUTION 2015-2

### COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF KENT COUNTY, MARYLAND

**WHEREAS**, the County Commissioners of Kent County, Maryland recognizes the Annotated Code of Maryland, Business Regulations Article, Title 17- §1006 requires certain individuals doing business as a junk dealer or scrap metal processor in the State of Maryland be licensed to engage in said business; and

**WHEREAS**, the County Commissioners of Kent County, Maryland recognizes the Annotated Code of Maryland, Business Regulations Article, Title 17-§1003 requires that a county or municipal governing body in the county in which the license of the junk dealer or scrap metal processor is held, shall designate by resolution the primary law enforcement unit to receive records in accordance with the statute.


**WHEREAS**, the County Commissioners of Kent County, Maryland recognizes similar provisions in Title 12 of the Annotated Code of Maryland, Business Regulations Article apply to dealers in second hand precious metal objects and pawnbrokers.

#### **NOW, THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF KENT COUNTY, MARYLAND THAT:**

1. The Kent County Sheriff's Office is hereby designated as the Primary Law Enforcement Unit for Kent County, Maryland in regards to the enforcement of the regulations as set forth in Title 17, Subtitle 10 and Title 12 of the Annotated Code of Maryland, Business Regulations Article.
2. The Kent County Sheriff's Office shall receive records in accordance with Title 12- §304 and Title 17-§1011(b) of the Annotated Code of Maryland, Business Regulations Article.
