KCSO Deputies have countless interactions with the citizenry of and visitors to Kent County. Of the seven (7) complaints investigated, three (3) were initiated by civilians and all three(3) were non-sustained after thorough, unbiased investigations. The four (4) sustained investigations were as a result of the diligence and effective supervision of the Patrol Division Commander to maintain internal compliance with agency rules and regulations.
