NOW THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF KENT COUNTY, MARYLAND that Article VI Special Provisions, and Article XI Definitions of the *Kent County Land Use Ordinance* is hereby amended as follows:

ARTICLE VI. SPECIAL PROVISIONS

Section 9.8 Review and Approval of Erosion and Sediment Control Plans

7. Approved plans remain valid for two (2) **THREE** (3) years from the date of approval unless extended or renewed by the *approving agency*.

ARTICLE XI. DEFINITIONS

Section 2 Definitions

147.5 <u>Grading Unit</u> - The maximum contiguous area allowed to be graded at a given time. For the purposes of *erosion and sediment control*, a grading unit is 20 acres or less.** THE MAXIMUM CONTIGUOUS AREA ALLOWED TO BE GRADED AT A GIVEN TIME AND CAN BE ESTABLISHED ON A SITE SPECIFIC BASIS.
