The holders of a CLASS A, CLASS B, CLASS C, CLASS D may sell alcoholic beverages, as defined on the issued license, from 6:00 a.m. to 2:00 a.m. the following day. *Or unless otherwise provided/specified*

24-2002 Beer, 24-2003 Beer and Wine, 24-2004 Beer, Wine, and Liquor

The holder of a CLASS B Wine Shop and Lounge may sell wine: Monday through Friday, from 6:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. the following day; on Saturday, from 6:00 a.m. to 1:00 a.m.; and on Sunday from 9:00 a.m. to midnight, for off-premise consumption only. *Or: unless otherwise provided/specified*

24-1003 Wine

CLASS A - No Consumption on Premises

May sell in a sealed package or container; package may not be opened, and its contents may not be consumed on the premises where sold; off-premise.

24-601 Beer, 24-701 Wine, 24-802 Beer and Wine, 24-901 Beer, Wine, and Liquor

BWLT Tasting - a CLASS A *companion

*Authorizes the holder to allow an individual to taste on-premise, as defined/specified; and offerings/ounces are limited.

CLASS B - Consumption on Premises

A hotel or restaurant that accommodates the public; percentage requirement sales of food 25%

May sell at retail for consumption on-premise and off-premise.

24-602 Beer, 24-803 Beer and Wine, 24-902 Beer, Wine, and Liquor

24-1001 Bed and Breakfast: on-premise; guests only; hours same as 24-2004

24-1002 Country Inn: on-premise; guests only; hours same as 24-2004

24-1003 Wine Shop and Lounge: on-premise / off-premise with limitations; no percentage of food sales required; no age limits; hours of sale limited.

CP - Caterer's Privilege- a CLASS B *companion

*Local License applicable to Kent County; and (food requirement) shall provide food for consumption at the catered event.

CLASS C – Consumption on Premises

A nonprofit organization or club; operates only for use of its members and guests.

May sell at retail at the club for consumption on-premise and off-premise.

24-903 Beer, Wine, and Liquor

CLASS D – Consumption on Premises

21 or older to enter; may sell at retail for consumption on-premise and off-premise.

24-604 Beer, 24-904 Beer, Wine, and Liquor

OTHER VENUES

Use of a theater; may sell at retail for consumption on-premise; limited hours.
