### CODE HOME RULE BILL NO. 2-2017

AN ACT to amend Chapter 152 Taxation to add Article VIII Property Tax Credit – Commerce Zones §152-33, §152-34, and §152-35, to the Code of Public Local Laws of Kent County, Maryland for the purpose of authorizing a certain property tax credit for certain business entities that obtain certain new, improved, or expanded premises in a certain commerce zones in Kent County; providing for the amount and duration of the property tax credit; authorizing the County Commissioners of Kent County to provide, by law, for certain matters relating to the tax credit; defining certain terms; providing for the application of this Act; and generally relating to a property tax credit in Kent County for real property located in certain commerce zones.

### **PUBLIC HEARING**

HAVING been posted and notice of time and place of hearing and copies having been made available to the public and the press, a public hearing was held on May 30, 2017. Reported favorably [WAN] [without] amendments; read second time and ordered to be considered on June 6, 2017, a legislative session day.

### A BILL ENTITLED CHR 2-2017 PROPERTY TAX CREDIT – COMMERCE ZONES

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF KENT COUNTY, MARYLAND that Chapter 152, Taxation is hereby amended to add Article VIII, §152-33, §152-34, and §152-35, as follows:

# ARTICLE VIII PROPERTY TAX CREDIT – COMMERCE ZONES

## §152-33 PROPERTY TAX CREDIT – COMMERCE ZONES

- (A) DEFINITIONS. IN THIS ARTICLE THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED:
- (1) "COMMERCE ZONE" MEANS A PRIORITY FUNDING AREA IN KENT COUNTY DESIGNATED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF KENT COUNTY AS A COMMERCE ZONE AND ADOPTED BY RESOLUTION.
- (2) "NEW, IMPROVED, OR EXPANDED PREMISES" MEANS COMMERCIAL OR INDUSTRIAL REAL PROPERTY, INCLUDING A BUILDING OR PART OF A BUILDING THAT HAS NOT BEEN PREVIOUSLY OCCUPIED, WHERE A BUSINESS ENTITY LOCATES TO CONDUCT BUSINESS.
- (B) PROGRAM. THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF KENT COUNTY MAY GRANT, BY LAW, A PROPERTY TAX CREDIT UNDER THIS SECTION AGAINST THE COUNTY PROPERTY TAX IMPOSED ON OR AFTER JULY 1, 2015 ON REAL PROPERTY OWNED BY A BUSINESS ENTITY THAT MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS SPECIFIED UNDER THIS ARTICLE.

## §152-34 QUALIFICATIONS FOR PROPERTY TAX CREDIT – COMMERCE ZONES.

- (A) TO QUALIFY FOR A PROPERTY TAX CREDIT UNDER THIS SECTION, A BUSINESS ENTITY SHALL OBTAIN NEW, IMPROVED, OR EXPANDED PREMISES IN A COMMERCE ZONE BY:
  - (1) PURCHASING NEWLY CONSTRUCTED PREMISES;
  - (2) CONSTRUCTING NEW PREMISES;
  - (3) CAUSING NEW PREMISES TO BE CONSTRUCTED; OR

(4) IMPROVING EXISTING PREMISES FOR OCCUPATION BY THE BUSINESS ENTITY.

## §152-35 COMPUTATION OF PROPERTY TAX CREDIT COMMERCE ZONES

- (A) IF A BUSINESS ENTITY MEETS THE DEFINITIONS AND REQUIREMENTS UNDER SECTIONS 153-33 AND 153-34 OF THIS ARTICLE, THE PROPERTY TAX CREDIT GRANTED UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL EQUAL A PERCENTAGE OF THE AMOUNT OF COUNTY PROPERTY TAX IMPOSED ON THE ASSESSMENT OF THE NEW, IMPROVED, OR EXPANDED PREMISES, AS FOLLOWS:
  - (1) 50% FOR EACH OF THE FIRST 5 TAXABLE YEARS;
  - (2) 25% IN TAXABLE YEARS 6 AND 7;
  - (3) 15% IN TAXABLE YEARS 8 THROUGH 10; AND
  - (4) 0% FOR EACH TAXABLE YEAR THEREAFTER.

<u>SECTION 3</u>. **BE IT FURTHER ENACTED** by the County Commissioners of Kent County that this Act shall take effect on the  $20^{th}$  day of July, 2017.
