NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Pursuant to the requirements of the, Environment Article, Title 9, Subtitle 5, §9-503(d) County Plans of the Annotated Code of Maryland, and as required by the Maryland Department of the Environment in compliance with Section 9-507(a) of the Environment Article, Annotated Code of Maryland, Kent County shall amend the 10-year Solid Waste/Recycling Management Plan to include the subject of Office Building Recycling. More specifically, the Office Building Recycling plan requires the collection of recyclable materials from office buildings that have 150,000 square feet or greater of office space; requiring each owner of an office building to provide recycling receptacles for the collection of recyclable materials and for the removal of certain materials for further recycling by October 1, 2021; authorizing certain enforcement units to conduct certain inspections.


The County Commissioners of Kent County will hold a Public Hearing on September 8, 2020 at 10:00 a.m. in the County Commissioners' Hearing Room, R. Clayton Mitchell Jr., Kent County Government Center, 400 High Street, Chestertown, MD 21620, for the purpose of discussing the proposed text amendment to the Kent County Solid Waste/Recycling Management Plan. In response to the State of Emergency, and in lieu of public appearance, the meeting will be held remotely, via video teleconference and viewable on the County website at www.kentcounty.com/government. Hearings are open to the public written comments will be accepted until noon on September 4, 2020.
