

## PUBLIC PARK USE GUIDELINES NOTICE

~March 23, 2020~

The following policies related to park entry, capacity and enforcement have been implemented at all Kent County parks in accordance with

Governor Larry Hogan's Proclamation for a State of Emergency and Existence of Catastrophic Health Emergency - COVID-19

- County parks are **OPEN FOR PUBLIC USE** for lawful recreational pursuits during daylight hours, with **RESTRICTIONS AS OUTLINED HEREIN** this notice.
  - o Amenities cordoned off with caution tape or other restrictive barrier are **CLOSED** for public use.
  - o Restroom facilities are **CLOSED/NOT AVAILABLE** until the official park opening season (April 1-October 31).
- All exclusive use reservations (fields, ball diamonds, pavilions, etc.) are **CANCELLED**.
  - o New reservations are not permitted until further notice.
- Patrons should responsibly follow gathering and social distancing guidance from the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and Maryland Department of Health (MDH) to ensure a safe environment for employees and other guests.
- High congestion, traffic and use areas such as courts (contact sports such as basketball), select parking lots, pavilions, playgrounds and shelters are **CLOSED** for public use.
- Water fountain (if applicable) is **CLOSED** for public use.
- County Government employees/park personnel shall disperse groups and large gatherings (>10 people) and reserve the right to request assistance from LAW ENFORCEMENT.
- **PRACTICE SOCIAL DISTANCING** by keeping distance between yourself and others and avoiding crowds.
  - o Social distancing is the best way to slow the spread of COVID-19.
    - Avoid handshaking, hugging and other intimate types of greeting Avoid non-essential travel Avoid crowds, especially in poorly ventilated spaces Avoid unnecessary errands consider ways to have essential items, like food and other household supplies, brought to you through delivery services or through family or social networks.
