The Kent County Agricultural Preservation Advisory Board met on Thursday, June 18, 2020, virtually online through video conference. Prior to discussing the applications for review, Mr. Tracey reviewed the Kent County Conflict of Interest policy.

Mr. Tracey reviewed the FY2021 Easement Application Rankings.

Mr. Tracey said thirty applications were received to sell an easement. Only twelve applications may be submitted to MALPF for appraisal. However, MALPF is accepting up to five additional applications in case any substitutions are necessary to replace farms from the twelve that receive FY2020 Round 2 offers before the applications are submitted to the Department of General Services.

After discussion, the Board voted on each application and recommended the applications be submitted to MALPF for appraisal.

GENERAL DISCUSSION:


There was a brief discussion about the roles and responsibilities of the Kent County Agricultural Preservation Advisory Board.


Ms. Gerber said there is an open vacancy on the board. She said interested applicants should write a letter of interest or submit their name for consideration.
