LOGGING PERMIT PROCEDURES & CONTACT INFORMATION

- 1. The logging applicant contacts the Maryland Department of Natural Resources (DNR) Forest Service office by phone or e-mail for the forest harvest operation plan documents.
- 2. The MD DNR Forest Service office will e-mail the approved forest harvest operation plan to the Kent County Planning, Housing, and Zoning office, Permit Specialist.
- 3. The MD DNR Forest Service will provide the applicant with the county permit specialist's contact information. The logging applicant contacts Kent County's Permit Specialist for the county's logging-sediment control application and fee schedule.
- 4. The logging applicant completes and submits the permit application, a hard copy of the forest harvest plan approved by the MD DNR Forest Service office and the permit fee to the Kent Planning office by mail or in person.
- 5. The permit specialist processes the permit application and e-mails it to the Kent Soil and Water Conservation District (KSWCD) and other applicable agencies for their review.
- 6. When all approvals have been received, the permit specialist will contact the logging applicant for permit pick-up.
