The subject that concerns me and several of my neighbors is an item discussed in the Sept. 8th meeting regarding the inclusion of Wedding events in the Agricultural district. We are concerned that a blanket use by right of this use in the agricultural without the opportunity of a hearing to hold an applicant to adhere to standards unique to the site, like parking facilities, sanitary facilities, design standards for traffic, and noise restrictions would be a burden to adjacent residents who are only interested in enjoying the piece and solitude that drew us to Kent County in the first place.

I understand that this is only step one of the process, and we aren't even certain that the current owner of the property that concerns us even has an interest in pursuing the use of their property as a wedding venue but regardless as you know once an ordinance is in place it is difficult to put the toothpaste back in the tube.
