What is Zoning?

Divides all land into districts based on primary uses

Can establish an ideal property size for each district

Provides for setbacks based on ideal property size

Places every property into a district using a Map

What is Comprehensive Rezoning?

A review of the entire Zoning Code – text and map

Any member of the public can request text changes

Any property owner can request new zoning district

Why now?

Follows adoption of a new Comprehensive Plan

Kent County adopted new Comp Plan in April 2018

Kent County's last major update completed in 2002

How is the Zoning Code being reviewed?

A national consultant provides broad zoning expertise

Local team manages ads, logistics, meetings, minutes

2. Review zoning code map – entertain all proposals
